This letter will serve as verification of the natural gas capabilities currently available at the Job Ready Site (JRS) at County Road 25 A and Short Road in Wapakoneta.

As previously discussed, Dominion currently has two four-inch high pressure lines adjacent to the property. The lines are located on both County Road 24A and Short Road. The current pressure on the line is 180 pounds with an MAOP of 275 pounds. Providing up to 150,000 CFH, this should meet the requirements for most industrial/manufacturing end-users. Should a potential customer require a greater load, upgrades could be made.

The first step would be to determine actual load and perform detailed engineering/cost studies. In the event that a customer would require a load greater than the current infrastructure could serve and anticipated revenues from that load are sufficient to fund the investment, the cost to increase capacity would be the responsibility of Dominion and would not fall on the end-user. Please keep in mind that a line installation project of such magnitude could take anywhere from 12 to 18 months to complete, as it would require obtaining the necessary approvals and constructing an eight-inch high pressure line for several miles to the site.

We are pleased with the prospect of this site in Auglaize County and the economic impact it can have in the communities we serve. We look forward to the continued cooperation and professional working relationship we have so enjoyed with you and your staff.
