Electrical Service to Wapakoneta Site**

This letter is to confirm that the Wapakoneta Municipal Electric Department is responsible for electrical service to the Wapakoneta O.J.R.S. As part of its commitment to this project, the city has constructed a new primary electric line to the O.J.R.S. The delivery voltage is 69,000 volts. We hereby verify that there is in excess of 6 megawatts (MW) demand capacity available to serve new industrial sites within the O.J.R.S.

Our records indicate that in the past twenty four months there have been zero events that led to power interruption in excess of five (5) minutes in this area of the city. The current average use of the city's delivery point reaches a demand of thirty-six (36) MW during summer peek. The annual average daily demand is thirty (30) MW.

The city has two primary substations which will serve the O.J.R.S. The combined capacity of these substations is 1,111 Amps at 12, 470 volts. The peak combined consumption for these two substations during 2008 was 470 Amps.

The major industrial consumers served by these two substations include Koneta Rubber, Midwest Elastomers, Millers Textile, American Industrial Partners, G.A., Wintzer and Sons, American Trim, V-Maxx, Inc, On-Time Machine and Kantner Ingredients.

We hope this meets your current needs for information regarding the electrical distribution system serving the Wapakoneta O.J.R.S.
